




# Acquisition Professional Requirements

## MOS 8059 – Acquisition Professional

### Consolidated Career Path

*Lieutenant through General*



### Eligibility Criteria for MOS 8057

#### Acquisition Professional Candidate:

- Unrestricted Commissioned Officers
- Level II certified in primary career field
- Two years of acquisition experience
- Identified by leadership as potential future acquisition professional
- MOS assigned by MMOA upon notification from MARCORSSYSCOM

### Eligibility Criteria for MOS 8058

#### Acquisition Manager:

- Unrestricted Major, Lt Colonel or Colonel
- Four years acquisition experience (12 months pursuing program of academics can be counted towards the 4 years experience)
- Bachelors degree
- 24 business credit hours OR 24 science/math and 12 business
- Level II certified in primary career field
- MOS assigned by MMOA upon notification from MARCORSSYSCOM

### Eligibility Criteria for MOS 8059

#### Acquisition Management Professional:

- Unrestricted Major, Lt Colonel or Colonel
- Four years acquisition experience. (12 months pursuing program of academics can be counted towards the 4 years experience)
- Bachelors degree
- 24 business credit hours OR 24 science/math and 12 business
- Level II certified in primary career field
- Officer applies for selection by Annual Acquisition Management Professional Selection Board
