HARD FACE MICROFLEECE CAP

Overview: The Hard Face Microfleece Cap is intended to provide the individual Marine thermal protection for the head, forehead, and ears against the elements, primarily in cold weather environments.

Features: The Hard Face Microfleece Cap is worn with combat uniforms and the Extended Cold Weather Clothing System (ECWCS). It is lighter, less bulky, and quicker drying than the knit cap. The Hard Face Microfleece Cap integrates well with helmets, head communication sets, and the ECWCS parka hood.
