#### MODULAR INTEGRATED COMMUNICATIONS HELMET

**Overview:** The Modular Integrated Communications Helmet (MICH) is a component of the Full Spectrum Battle Equipment (FSBE), TAMCN C35012E. The MICH has less area coverage in the front and sides and tapers to the same location of the neck as the Lightweight Helmet (LWH).

**Features:** The MICH provides protection in various operating environments from blunt impact, fragmentation, and 9mm small arms projectiles. The MICH is a Tactical Cut Helmet that reduces overall helmet system weight due to reduced coverage discussed in the Overview.

**Components:** Ballistic shell, suspension pads (3/4 or 1 inch thick), retention system, reversible helmet cover, Nape Protection Pad (NAPP), and use and care manual.

**Approved Acquisition Objective (AAO):** The MICH quantity authorized for peacetime and wartime requirements to equip and sustain the force in accordance with current DoD plans and policies is listed in the table below:
