PROTECTIVE OVER GARMENT

Overview: The Tier II Protective Over Garment (POG) can be worn over the outer garment by any Marine regardless of Military Occupational Specialty (MOS). It is worn as a single piece article with three interoperable components capable of individual adjustment. The POG provides protection equal to the standard body armor. Protection is provided to the groin and perineum.

Features: The POG provides protection from fragmentation for the groin and perineum in explosive events for Marines. The POG can be worn on the back of the belt and, when needed unrolled, passed between the legs and attached to the front of the warfighter's belt.

Components: Carrier Front, Carrier Center, Carrier Rear, Front Armor, Center Armor, Rear Armor.

Approved Acquisition Objective (AAO): The POG quantity authorized for peacetime and wartime requirements to equip and sustain the force in accordance with current DoD plans and policies is listed in the table below.
