PROTECTIVE UNDERGARMENT

Overview: The Tier I Protective Undergarment (PUG) is a light weight undergarment that provides wound mitigation for Marines and Sailors subjected to Improvised Explosive Device (IED) attacks by protecting the skin in the groin and upper leg area from the subcutaneous insertion of sand and small debris.

Features: In addition to its ballistic capabilities, the undergarment is antimicrobial; flame resistant (objective no melt, no drip); allows for the transmission of water vapor; air permeable; made of stretchable fabric; and requires no special care and handling.
