USMC SUB-BELT

Overview: The USMC Sub-belt replaces the cartridge belt and provides a hip-worn platform for carriage of fielded pouches and the USMC Holster via Pouch Attachment Ladder System (PALS). It is distributed in three sizes and is part of the Family of Individual Load Bearing Equipment (ILBE).

Features: The USMC Sub-belt allows for tailorable load configurations with the PALS compatible pouches and equipment. It can be worn with or without the fielded body armor systems.

Components: The USMC Sub-belt consists of an adjustable hip belt and shoulder harness.

Approved Acquisition Objective (AAO): The USMC Sub-belt quantity authorized for peacetime and wartime requirements to equip and sustain the force in accordance with current DoD plans and policies is listed in the table below:
