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## **Marine Corps Systems Command conducts an 'Acquisition Excellence' day for all command employees**

WOODBIDGE, Va. – Approximately 800 Marines, federal civilians and support contractors will attend Marine Corps Systems Command's (MCSC) annual Acquisition Excellence (AE) Day scheduled to take place tomorrow, Wednesday, June 6, from 8 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. at the Hylton Events Center in Woodbridge, Va.

AE Day focuses on the professional and personal development and growth of the MCSC workforce, bringing in speakers from across government and industry to expose the command to new and innovative ideas, to motivate and teach, and to impart methodologies and practices which can aid the command in reaching its goals of being a high-performing, team-based learning organization.

The event's keynote speaker this year is Lt. Gen. John Sattler, Director for Strategic Plans and Policy, J-5, Joint Staff.
