

The C7915 (GMTK) is a SAC 1 Type 1 End Item. The MARCORSYSCOM Program Management Office (PMO) does not provide disposition instructions for SAC 1 items. Course Of Actions are provided below to replace C7915 (GMTK's).

1. Using units determine disposition/disposal of SAC 1 items due to their procurement via unit funds. Units should coordinate with local supply IOT determine which GMTK's should be disposed and if unit funds are available for replacement. When disposing of GMTKs units should turn assets into DLA Disposition Services (formerly DRMO) using a DD Form 1348 Issue Release/Receipt Document.
2. The PMO recommends units redistribute serviceable tools/items to the maximum extent possible. This will conserve unit funds and is fiscally responsible.
3. Using Units are required to submit a Service Request (SR) in GCSS-MC for replacement GMTK's.
4. The following are the (3) variants of the C7915 GMTK currently supported with replacement tools available through NSN, GSA or open purchase:

A) 5180-01-605-5146 (U/P \$1762.00) Snap-On - in a foldable two lid Snap-On case. This is a new Joint-GMTK contracted by the Army for all DoD Services. This is now the Preferred GMTK under TAMCN C7915. The PMO recommends units buy the preferred NSN when requisitioning new GMTKs.

B) 5180-01-554-4224 Armstrong - Pelican Box NO LONGER PROCURABLE OR AUTHORIZED TO REQUISITION (considered obsolete). This NSN is authorized to hold & use until exhausted. The majority of USMC GMTK's currently in the field are the Armstrong (Apex Tools) provided GMTK (in a Pelican Box). Over 12,000 GMTKs were bought and fielded to USMC units from 2009-2017. Individual units should retain and maintain these GMTK's as long as practical (Note: The decision on how long and how to maintain is up to individual units). Recommend owning units redistribute servable tools from other Armstrong GMTK's prior to delivery to DLA Disposition Services in order to replenish tools in existing Armstrong GMTK's that are SL-3 deficient (less than 65% complete). Note: owning units determine when to dispose of SAC-1 GMTK's.

C) 4910-01-620-3116 (U/P \$3521.76) Snap-On - in a one lid Snap-On case is Authorized under TAMCN C7915. This was an interim solution for the USMC while the Army determined acquisition process on the new J-GMTK. This is a good GMTK; however, more costly.
