Overview: The Combat Desert Jacket (CDJ) is a lightweight, wind resistant, water repellent jacket intended to provide multi-season environmental protection in desert environments.

Features: The CDJ has the following features: five pockets with water resistant zipper closures; two chest, two lower front, and one upper sleeve pocket; a rank tab on the left front chest; a balaclava (hood) that can be stowed in the collar; lightweight four-way stretch material in the underarm and upper back panels to reduce bulk and provide mobility and ventilation; sleeves with reinforced elbows, and adjustable wrist closures.
