Overview: The Hand-Held Flash Light (HHFL) uses white light, which reduces signature and provides the ability to follow blood trails (blue light), read maps (red light), and operate more effectively at night (Infrared (IR) light).

Features: Light source of white (primary color), red, blue, and IR without lenses with adjustable illumination for all colors. Additional features consist of white light output at 20 Lumens; IR wavelength of 880 nanometers without use of a filter; red and blue light source that provides and output that is not under 80% transmission at a wavelength of 650 nanometers; strobe capability with all light sources; compatible with all DOD inventory AA batteries; operation time per battery load of eight hours; belt/clothing clip capable of suspending a 10 pound load; compact size, 8.5 inches; operating temperature -40°F to 150°F; pivoting head with more than 90 degrees of rotation; waterproof to 3 feet of water for a duration of one hour.
