Features: Latest technology provides a light weight, durable and mobile platform for transporting equipment and supplies over snow covered terrain. Harness pulling system ergonomically designed to aide Marines during sled movement.

Components: Sled, Transport Bag, Compression Straps, Main Harnesses, Assist Harnesses, Carabineers, Pole Sets, Climbing Skins, Fuel bottle and funnel, Cook set, Snow Shovel with handle, Ski wax kit, Snow saw with cover, Hatchet with cover, Avalanche Probes with stuff sack, Tent Whisk and Dust Pan, Thermos, and Extra Stoppers.
