Overview: The Mechanical Breacher's Kit (MBK) possesses the basic equipment necessary to breach obstacles not requiring the use of an explosive or ordnance.

Features: The MBK is designed to support Infantry Platoons operating in an urban or built-up area to complete a typical mission profile consisting of punching, pulling, prying, and pushing and would include breaching locked doors, walls, cutting chainlink fences, and wire obstacles.

Components: Bolt cutters with carrier, sledge hammer with carrier, sledge axe with carrier, Halligan tool with carrier, ladder carrier, kit accessory bag, wrecking bar, and several other components that make up the MBK.
