Overview: The Military Ski System (MSS) will provide an update to the current antiquated Marine Corps ski, which has been in the inventory since 1993 and now faces obsolescence issues.

Features: The MSS will be made of a lightweight, flexible, noncorrosive material, designed to allow the novice skier to operate in snowfield conditions with minimal training. The MSS will provide Marines additional mobility for operating on snow in mountains, open areas and forested areas. Additionally, the MSS will provide Marines with the capability to conduct cross-country missions in forward deployed cold weather environments.
