Overview: The Ultra High Intensity Miniature Illumination System (UHIMIS) provides Marines with a lightweight, portable, long-range illuminator to aid in the detection and identification of enemy, noncombatant and friendly forces both overtly and covertly.

Features: The UHIMIS will provide a readily available, long-range visible light and infrared illumination capability across the Marine Air Ground Task Force (MAGTF). This capability will enhance the effectiveness, survivability, and lethality of Marines throughout the span of tasks conducted at night with specific impact on the conduct of vehicle/personnel checkpoints and defensive operations.
