Overview: The Lightweight Helmet (LWH) replaced the Personal Armor System for Ground Troops (PASGT) helmet, also known as the Kevlar. The LWH provides protection in various operating environments from blunt impact, fragmentation, and 9mm projectiles.

Features: The LWH retains the PASGT design but uses lighter materials enabled by newer technologies. The LWH is lighter than the PASGT, depending on helmet size, and provides greater combat effectiveness through greater comfort and improved fit. It features a retention system and pads that reduce stress and fatigue on the neck and shoulders. The LWH is available in six sizes, ranging from extra-small to extra-extra-large.

Components: Ballistic Shell, suspension hook disks (hook and loop fastener), suspension pads (3/4 or 1 inch thick), retention assembly, attaching hardware, edging (finish and labels), and use and care manual.

Concept of Distribution: One per Marine. Item available at the CSP. The Enhanced Combat Helmet will replace the LWH during the FY2018-2020 timeframe. Training commands and other Supporting Establishment units will retain the LWH.
