Overview: The Modular Integrated Communications Helmet (MICH) is a component of the Full Spectrum Battle Equipment (FSBE), TAMCN C35012E. The MICH has less area coverage in the front and sides and tapers to the same location of the neck as the Lightweight Helmet (LWH).

Features: The MICH provides protection in various operating environments from blunt impact, fragmentation, and 9mm projectiles. The MICH is a Tactical Cut Helmet that reduces overall helmet system weight due to reduced coverage discussed in the overview.

Components: Ballistic shell, suspension pads (3/4 or 1 inch thick), retention system, reversible helmet cover, and use and care manual.

Concept of Distribution: One per FSBE Individual Kit. The Enhanced Combat Helmet will replace the MICH during the FY2018-2020 timeframe. Training commands and other Supporting Establishment units will retain the MICH.

Fielding Status: Fielding complete

Requirements Document: The FSBE Statement of Need, Change 2, dated 14 Jun 2010 validates the MICH requirements.

Training: A Quick Reference Guide (QRG) accompanies each helmet and explains with text and drawings how to adjust, wear, and maintain the helmet. Training can be coordinated through Program Manager, ICE.
