Overview: The Protective Undergarment (PUG) is a lightweight undergarment that provides wound mitigation and protection of the skin in the groin and upper leg area for Marines and Sailors subjected to the subcutaneous insertion of sand and small debris experienced during an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) attack.

Features: In addition to its ballistic capabilities, the undergarment is antimicrobial, flame resistant (objective: no melt, no drip), allows for the transmission of water vapor, is air permeable, is made of stretchable fabric, and requires no special care and handling. Available in male and female.
