Overview: The Side Enhanced Small Arms Protective Inserts (Side ESAPI) body armor is an integral part of the Family of Ballistic Protection Systems. It provides an increased area of coverage to the flank torso of the Marine by integrating into the side of the Improved Modular Tactical Vest (IMTV) and the Plate Carrier (PC). The Side ESAPI replaced the Side Small Arms Protective Insert for training and operations. Side ESAPI plates must have passed Non-Destructive Testing and have a Non-Destructive Test Equipment (NDTE) label affixed to be authorized for retention and use.

Features: The Side ESAPI consists of a ceramic composite outer strike face with laminated composite backing and is covered with a rubber, plastic, or nylon cover. Side ESAPIs can be removed from the IMTV/PC, allowing commanders to increase/decrease protection based on the threat. Contoured to fit the individual, plates are interchangeable between the left and right of the IMTV or PC. The Side ESAPI covers a Marine's vital organs and can withstand multiple hits.
