USMC PACK

Overview: The USMC Pack replaces the Improved Load Bearing Equipment (ILBE) field pack due to ILBE's lack of integration with fielded body armor systems.

Features: The USMC Pack consists of multiple bags and interchangeable pouches configurable to individual load carriage requirements.

Components: The USMC Pack consists of one main pack with an external frame, assault pack, assault pouch, hydration pouch, hydration system, sternum cinch, buckle repair kit, instruction card, and two sustainment pouches.
