Overview: The Maneuverable Canopy-6 (MC-6) is the replacement for the Personnel Parachute -7 (MC-7) parachute system.

MC-7 is a dual canopy parachute system comprised of both the MC-7 main parachute, T-11 harness, and the T-11R parachute. The Reconnaissance, Force Reconnaissance and MARSOC forces use the system for insertion into areas of operations.

Features: Low-level static line parachute

Components: Main and reserve parachutes
