Overview: The Intermediate Cold Weather Glove (ICWG) is composed of three layers – an insulation layer, a waterproof breathable insert, and an outer shell of a durable, water resistant/vapor permeable material (nylon, leather).

Features: The glove has a waterproof breathable insert. The outer shell is constructed in a gauntlet design that fits over the sleeve of the Extended Cold Weather Parka. It has a wrist closure designed to prevent the entry of cold air or snow. The ICWG is designed to be worn in cold weather environments to protect the user from snow, wind, and ice with a threshold temperature range from 40 degrees to 0 degrees Fahrenheit.
