PARACHUTE SYSTEM – 2

Overview: The Parachute System – 2 (PS – 2) (formally known as the E-MMPS) is a Ram Air Parachute System (RAPS) and will be a lifecycle replacement for the Multi-Mission Parachute System (MMPS) parachute system. The PS – 2 will provide greater compatibility with the MV-22 for increased operational capability from ship.

Features: This capability provides parachutist with the ability to conduct both High Altitude Low Opening (HALO) and High Altitude High Opening (HAHO) operations.

Components: The PS – 2 will consist of a main canopy, reserve canopy, harness/container assembly, and four deployment configurations.
