Overview: The Snow Camouflage Parka, Trousers, and Pack Cover are over-garments worn to prevent detection from the enemy in snow-covered terrain.

Features: The parka and trousers are designed with pass-through pocket openings and elastic or draw cord for sleeve, waist, trouser leg, and hood fitting adjustments. The integrated self-storage zippered pocket pouch allows the garment to be compressed for easy packing. The pack cover is designed to fit over the pack and is secured with a draw-cord. The snow camouflage uses a disruptive digitized snow camouflage print that is effective in various winter environments. Extremely lightweight, quick drying, and treated with a water repellent finish.
