TANDEM OFFSET RESUPPLY DELIVERY SYSTEM

Overview: The Tandem Offset Resupply Delivery System (TORDS) system allows a parachutist to deliver heavy loads (equipment or personnel) in conjunction with military free-fall operations, increasing the payload of required combat essential equipment.

Features: Parachute system to bring in heavy equipment and passengers
